VOTING PANEL

The BOT. A BOT member may be excused from voting if they request. If a BOT member has a child that has been nominated they may vote for their child. The process is decided by majority rule. There shall be no less than a quorum of five on the voting panel.

VOTING PROCEDURE

- All BOT members are eligible to vote
- BOT members may vote for their child
- Process of elimination will be used to choose the winner
- If there is a stale mate on the final vote, the Principal shall have the casting vote
