Dear Parents, Students and Community,

Another great week of learning here at Newstead Model Country School! It was great watching our children enjoy themselves at the recent Junior Water Fun Day and Senior Swimming Sports. We were lucky with the weather on both days. I enjoyed watching the little ones playing with water and participating in team events. Children go through different developmental stages of play and giving them opportunities to collaborate and cooperate is so important for their growth. Thank you to everyone involved in helping out or planning on both days. I would also like to thank Matangi School for the loan of their community swimming pool for the Senior Swimming Sports.

We're really looking forward to our PTA Fun Run this Saturday. I hope as many of you as possible come along to support this event. Kick off is at 4.00 pm. Any children who are not participating in the fundraising side of this event are more than welcome to come down and run. We'd love to see you there. Part of the proceeds from this event will be going toward a Shade Sail for our Entrance Way. We're well and truly into stage 2 of this development and it won't be too long now before it's in full use. Not only will it be an area for parents to sit and meet together at the end of the day, it will also be a valuable outside learning area for our children. The PTA, who have helped fundraise money for much of this project, work tirelessly for our school and we are so appreciative of all they do.

Over the next couple of weeks, I will be meeting with Constable Amy Bateman, our school Community Officer, and the District Council, to look at ways to improve the safety of the area of SH26 just in front of our school. Please take care when pulling out of our school, especially if you are turning right out of our carpark. We strongly encourage people to turn left when leaving the school and head towards Marshmeadow Road at busy times. I will keep you posted with any developments around this.

A reminder that our staff will be attending a Paid Union Meeting next Thursday afternoon. School will remain open for any children who need to stay at school. A letter was sent home about this last week.

This week, we have had a large number of children away from school with a vomiting bug. If your child is sick, please keep them home for at least 24 hours to minimise the risk of the bug spreading. We appreciate your cooperation with this.

Next Wednesday, our school will be hosting a group of Senior Leaders from neighbouring schools who are coming to look at the teaching and learning that is going on here at Newstead. It's a real privilege to have the opportunity to share ideas of what's working in our school with other professionals.

I was invited down to Wellington last Monday to spend the day working with a group of Principals from around the country. We met with Chris Hipkins, the Minister of Education, and his associate ministers, and looked at the state of education in New Zealand right now and what we can do to build on it. As you will be aware, the government has started a full review into education over the next few years. This review will hopefully involve all political parties and key stakeholders including students, parents and professionals from across the sector. The aim is to create a thirty year plan for education, regardless of who is in power at the time. Interesting times. One thing that came out strongly on Monday, was the need to focus on developing children's ability to be innovative and creative. This was pleasing to hear as we are also focusing on innovation and creativity at school. I watched Kiwi and Ruru classes working on their 'Marble Run' task on Thursday afternoon. Their task was to create a structure that would enable a marble to travel exactly one metre in length. The children were developing their skills in collaboration, creativity, observation, innovation and problem solving which was fantastic to see.



All the best for the weekend and I'll hopefully see many of you down at school for the Fun Run.

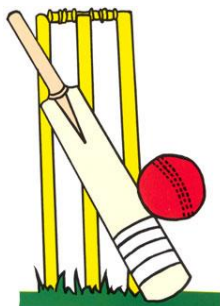
