Cricket Report...

Game 1 vs Horsham Downs Knights Won by default

Game 2 vs Endeavour Black Caps

A new look Strikers team took on the Endeavour Black Caps in an exciting 10 over per side game with all results possible with one ball remaining in the match. Having elected to field after winning the toss Newstead restricted Endeavour to 62/4. Jamie (2), Xavier and Avery took wickets with all the bowlers bowling well, the bowlers were well supported in the field, led by Xavier, Avery, Sam, Jamie, RJ and Christopher. In reply Newstead had good partnerships right through the innings but kept losing regular wickets to keep the game even.

Sam and RJ batted very well putting on a partnership of 25 runs including a big six and a four from Sam. Xavier and Christopher then closed out the innings with a partnership of 20 runs. Newstead's innings ended on 84/8 after Christopher scored two runs off the final ball (Sam 16, RJ 9, Luca 3, Rylee 6, Avery 10, Mikayla 6, Jamie 7, Zoe 3, Xavier 14 and Christopher 6). During this season's competition a team loses 5 runs for each wicket they lose; therefore, the final scores were Endeavour Black Caps 42 and the Newstead Knights 44, a win to the Newstead Knights by 2 runs.

The new players, Mikayla, Rylee, Zoe and Luca all made a great contribution to the team in their first games. Xavier and Jamie were named players of the day; Xavier for a fine all-round game, but particularly his batting where his ability to hit the gaps and his running between the wickets proved to be the difference between the teams; Jamie for showing greater awareness and urgency in the field, and her consistent, economical bowling which saw her claim two wickets.
