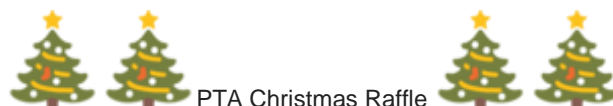

# KINA OMELETTE

**Ingredients:**

- 1 egg - beaten
- 100g of kina
- 50ml low-fat milk
- pepper - to taste
- herbs like parsley or chives - chopped (optional)
- 1 tbsp low-fat spread
- 1 or 2 slices of wholemeal toast to serve on
- lemon

Place beaten egg, kina, milk, herbs (if using) and pepper in a

bowl and stir to combine, trying not to break up the kina. Melt low-fat spread in a frying pan and pour in kina mixture. Cook until edges go frilly, then tilt the pan and draw the cooked egg into the centre, letting the uncooked egg run to the outside of the pan. Do this until the omelette is cooked. Fold omelette in half then slide onto toast. Sprinkle with a squeeze of lemon for some zing!

### Game 6 vs Te Rapa Red

A burst of rain just before the game didn't dampen the Strikers enthusiasm when they took on the Te Rapa Red team. The bowling performance from all the Striker bowlers was very good, bowling a tight line and proving difficult for the batsmen to hit. Christopher led the fielding effort affecting three run outs in consecutive deliveries to give Sam a hat trick, he was well supported by Xavier with two run outs as well as Zoe and Rylee who completed their first run outs. Sam (3), Zoe (2), Xavier (2) and Rylee took wickets.
