Tuesday Junior League Registrations Now Open

The Star Turf Tuesday Junior League is now open for registrations to players aged 7 through to 12 years old but will be closing on Thursday 7th February.

You can register as an individual via the on-line registration form in the link below (and we will place you in a team), but if you wish to request to play in the same team as a friend, please leave a note in the Comments section of the form with the name of that friend.

You can register as a team if you have enough players together, but to do that please contact us directly in the first instance.

The league will run for 8 weeks, starting on Tuesday February 12th and finishing on Tuesday 2nd April.

Players need to be registered and the entry fee needs to be paid by Friday 8th February or they will not be placed in a team.

Teams will be finalised and the draw made after the payment cut-off date.

There will be 1 week of grading games, and we may change players in certain teams to ensure a fair and balanced league.

Introduction to Goalkeeping Sessions Now Open

Bookings for the Introduction to Goalkeeping courses (a 4 week program) for both Youth (8 - 14 years of age) and Senior (14+ years of age) players are now open but MUST close on Friday 8th February.

These sessions will be run by Just4Keepers' Kim Brierley.

Kim has played at a semi professional level in England and has previously been involved with the National League side Waikato FC and has worked with New Zealand U17's Goalkeepers.

He was previously the youth goalkeeping coach to the WaiBop Federation. Kim has also coached the National Women's league Goalkeepers and is also the goalkeeping coach to the Northern 2nd Division side Cambridge FC. Previous to this role, he was with Ngarauwahia in their Northern league coaching group so has extensive experience and knowledge that he now wants to pass onto our young and elder keepers here at Star Turf and is looking forward to getting started.

Kim held OFC Level 2 goalkeepers and is also classed a FIFA goalkeepers instructor having attended a FIFA goalkeeping workshop with New Zealand Football. He is also a goalkeeping coach educator with NZ Football due to his previous involvement with WaiBop.

Sessions are penciled in to start on Wednesday 13th February from 5pm for Youth goalkeepers (from 8 up to 14 years of age) and 6.10 pm for Senior goalkeepers (14 years and older).

There will be a 4 week introductory program, which will progress into 6 week terms.

The cost will be \$20 per session for Youth goalkeepers and \$30 per session for Senior goalkeepers.

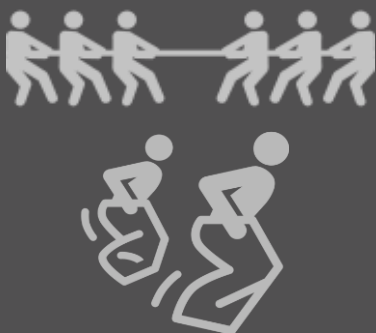
