Sunday 5-a-side Team Needed!

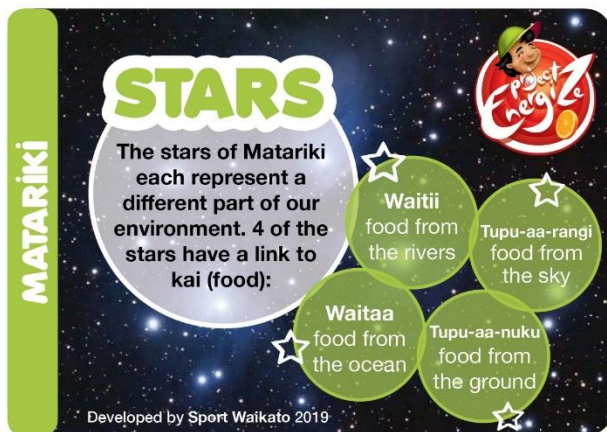
We have a place has opened up for a new senior 5-a-side team to compete for 7 weeks in Div B of our new Sunday league starting this weekend.
