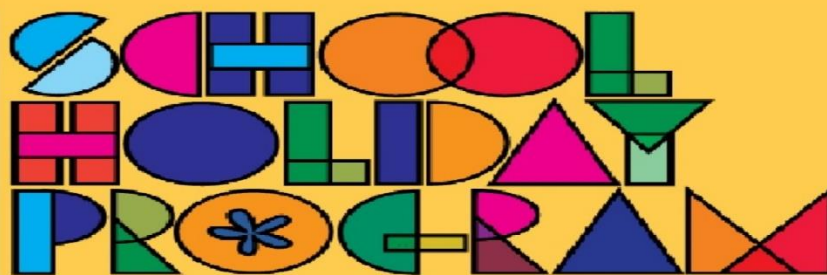

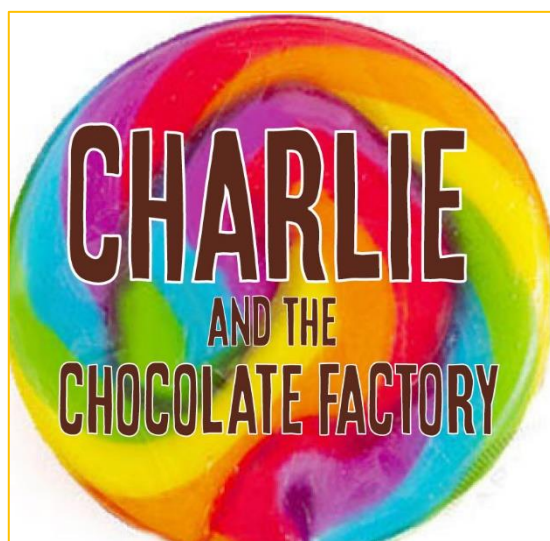
Squiggle Holiday Programme – 8th – 19th July 2019
