

Saturday music classes

Enrolments are now open for Term Three 2019 at the Waikato Community School of Music (formerly Hamilton Community Centre of Music). **The first session is on Saturday 3rd August.** The school caters for all ages (3 to retired) and ability levels. We offer both **group-format** music tuition in a range of instruments, as well as an Exam Stream **one-to-one** option for students who wish to prepare for external exams and/or work towards NCEA credits. Group-format class fees range from \$39 to \$99 per term (average 8 lessons) depending on age and instrument. The enrolment fee for an instrument class includes participation in as many of our ensembles as the student wishes.

A music appreciation/readiness programme (*Music Makers*) is available from age 3. *Young Voices* children's choir caters for those ages 9+. Class times are between 8am and 1:00pm on Saturdays during primary school terms. The centre is located on the University of Waikato campus in Hillcrest.
