One of the biggest changes in children's mathematical abilities comes when they can see that numbers can be split apart and put back together efficiently. This often happens around Year 3. Children initially count on to solve problems like $18 + 5$, they will say 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23.

Once they are thinking more mathematically, they will see this as $18 + 2$ is 20 and 3 more is 23. This opens up a world of opportunity for them.

One-day closure of Ruakura Road at bridge site

On Saturday 31 August, Ruakura Road will be closed under the East Coast Main Trunk rail bridge. The closure will allow steel roadside barriers to be safely installed under the bridge.

The road closure will be in place from 6.00am to 7.00pm but the road will reopen earlier if the work is completed earlier. Access for residents will be maintained at all times.

Ruakura Road will be closed to through traffic at the Silverdale Road roundabout and at the Holland Road intersection. Residents will still be allowed access to their properties. The traffic detour will be via Silverdale Road and SH26-Morrinsville Road.

If this work is cancelled due to bad weather, it will be carried out the following Saturday 7 September.
