Dear Parents, Students, and Community,

Tēnā koutou i ngā āhuatanga o te wā. Greetings to everyone. This week has been Māori Language Week. One of the aims of this week has been to start normalising this beautiful language in our daily lives. This has been something we've been working on here at Newstead over the last couple of years.

Well done to all the children who delivered either their poems or speeches this week. For many children this is a significant challenge for them and an opportunity to try and do something which makes them a bit nervous. Congratulations to the place getters and we look forward to the speech and poem finals next Tuesday.

Your child should have brought home a notice re-measles immunisation records if we didn't already have a copy. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. Again, at the moment we are **not** requiring your child to be vaccinated. We just need to have your child's immunisation status on record.

Today a number of our senior students are competing in the City Schools Cross Country which is being held at Hamilton Gardens. I will be able to let you know how we got on in next week's newsletter.

Our school has been working with SchoolDocs to create a website for our policies and procedures. We are excited to announce that the site is now live and available to our school community. The school works on a subscription basis with SchoolDocs to maintain, update, and review our policies. SchoolDocs provides us with a comprehensive core set of policies which have been well researched and follow the Ministry of Education National Administration Guidelines. The policies and procedures are tailored to our school, and the school supplies specific information such as our charter, and procedures for behaviour management, reporting to parents etc. SchoolDocs updates, modifies, or creates policies in response to changes in legislation or Ministry guidelines, significant events, reviews/requests from schools, and regular reviewing from the SchoolDocs team. Our board of trustees has the opportunity to view changes/additions and comment on them before they are implemented. A link to our school policies and procedures will be on our website very soon. We will let you know when this happens.
