Cricket Report – Newstead Red Hawks

Game 5 vs Matangi Magics

The Red Hawks travelled to Matangi to take on their country neighbours the Magics in what was a very exciting six-a-side match with the result not determined until the final ball was bowled. Having elected to field after winning the toss the Red Hawks put in a very good fielding performance to restrict the Magics to a score of 47/2 with our own Rylee playing for the opposition scoring 8 runs. Mikayla, Charlotte and Deniz bowled with good accuracy while Harrison picked up both wickets including hitting the stumps once. In reply Aiden and Charlotte got the Red Hawks off to a perfect start adding a season high 25 runs together with Aiden striking two superb fours. Zoe. L and Mikayla then had to contend with very accurate bowling with both batsmen keeping several deliveries out from hitting the wickets.

With the final over commencing the Red Hawks were well positioned to record the win with the score 45/0 but the loss of two wickets meant the result hinged on the final ball with the Magic's needing another wicket to snatch an unlikely victory. Despite the best efforts of the fieldsman to attempt the match winning run out, Deniz and Harrison made their ground to secure a narrow victory for the Red Hawk's. Final scores were Matangi 37 and Newstead 41, a win to Newstead by 4 runs. Aiden, Mikayla and Rylee were named players of the day. Aiden for his superb innings, the feature of which was his striking power and his running between the wickets. Mikayla for her fantastic all-round performance, bowling with accuracy, good defence with the bat and her awareness in the field and Rylee for her committed efforts playing for the opposition, scoring 8 runs and her improved accuracy whilst bowling.

CHINESE SWEET & SOUR PORK

Ingredients:

- 1/2 Tbsp oil
- 350g lean pork, diced
- 1 red capsicum, chopped
- 1 onion, finely chopped
- 1 carrot, sliced
- 1 can pineapple pieces in juice, drained
- 1/2 c pineapple juice
- 1 tsp ginger, grated
- 1 Tbsp soy sauce
- 1 1/2 Tbsp white vinegar
- 1 1/2 Tbsp tomato sauce
- 1 tsp brown sugar
- 1 Tbsp cornflour
- 2 Tbsp cold water

Heat oil in pan over high heat. Add pork. Stir-fry until lightly browned. Add veges. Stir-fry for 5mins. Add ginger, juice, soy sauce, vinegar, tomato sauce and sugar. Simmer until veges are just cooked. Dissolve cornflour in water, add to pan along with pineapple pieces and stir until sauce thickens. Serve with rice.


