Start Turf reboots it's Term 2 Star Soccer sessions from MONDAY 25 MAY and will run for 6 weeks until FRIDAY 5th JULY.

Level 2 - Level 4 : 8 to 13+ years of age

All sessions last for no more than 60 minutes.

We still have openings in our Tuesday and Thursday senior 5-a-side Indoor Leagues leagues for more teams, so if you know of anyone who may be interested in forming a team and joining one of those leagues - please get in touch ASAP.

Depending on the outcome of the update, we are hoping to resume the leagues, starting with the Sunday league from Sunday 31st May.

Things are of course still subject to change, and given that, things maybe somewhat different when you visit the centre.

Although we will do our best to ensure we adhere to the guidelines there is still a massive of level of Personal Responsibility that will need to be undertaken by our customers.

This will very likely to include things like ALL visitors signing in when entering the centre and trying as much as possible to adhere to the social distancing guidelines between different groups while in the centre, staying home if you feel unwell, and washing your hands before you enter the centre, and being respectful of the facilities and others by leaving all bags, drink bottles etc. off of the pitch (this is nothing new) and picking up your used bottles, rubbish after yourself and placing them in the bins provided or taking them home with you.

We will in touch again shortly, and continue to provide as much information about updates to our program and leagues as soon as possible via email and of course our Facebook page.

Please stay safe and abide by the recommendations from the Ministry of Health and our Government.

I KNOW, I THINK, I WONDER



One of the biggest changes in children's mathematical abilities comes when they can see that numbers can be split apart and put back together efficiently. This often happens around Year 3. Children initially count on to solve problems like $18 + 5$, they will say 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23.

Once they are thinking more mathematically, they will see this as $18 + 2$ is 20 and 3 more is 23. This opens up a world of opportunity for them.
