Dear Parents, Students and Community,

Last week I took our team of ten Student Mentors to a Country Schools Leadership Day run by Project Energize and Sport Waikato. The children participated in a number of problem solving activities that required lots of teamwork and collaboration, listen to guest speakers and mix with other student leaders from our Country Schools Cluster. I was very impressed with the way our children worked together, their attitude towards challenges, and their encouragement of each other. The Mentor's goal now is to introduce the games to our students, adapted obviously for the different year levels.



We're also fortunate to have Donna Barlow-Rolleston working with our staff and children every Monday morning helping us teach and learn Te Reo. Donna leads a Te Reo lesson with every class one week then helps the teacher take the same lesson the following week. We're having lots of fun with this and both students and staff are getting a lot from it. I know I am biased, but I'm always blown away by the staff and students willingness to give things a go and to grow and learn.

As slapped cheek is infectious before it is diagnosed, keeping your child home from preschool or school will not prevent the spread of the disease.

If you are exposed to slapped cheek, try to stop it spreading by making sure you and your children:

*wash your hands frequently

*cover your nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing

*do not share food, eating utensils and drink bottles.

Also try to avoid contact with pregnant women and people who have low immunity to disease.
