What's happening this week — beginning 30 July

SH26 roundabout construction

With the roundabout now functional under traffic management, the *Stabilising along Ruakura Road* team can now focus on constructing the centre of the roundabout and finishing the kerbs, footpaths and landscaping. Concrete trucks will be on site to begin pouring the concrete collar (rim of the roundabout). The team will carry out topsoiling

and general clean up when possible throughout the coming weeks.

Ruakura Road construction

The team completed stabilising works in between the roundabout and the entrance to the Old Macdonald Rural Education and Care Centre last week. Testing will take place in this area this week with the team running rock along the road from the roundabout heading north.

What's the plan for the next few weeks — beginning 6 August

Construction at the roundabout continues. We expect to be preparing and pouring the kerb near the LIC/Dairy NZ entrance next week. Footpath construction and landscaping will continue for the next few weeks. We will also look to start shaping and landscaping the centre of the roundabout. Once the centre of the roundabout is complete we will be able to place the final seal at the roundabout. The team be working on driveway accesses affected by the works on SH26 and Lissette Road. One of our team will come and see you if this is going to affect you.

If all is going to plan, the last utility relocations should begin next week in the 50m stretch of road north of Old Macdonald Rural Education and Care Centre. These works should take a week to complete. Once the utilities have been relocated we can then complete the last section of drainage and begin laying and stabilising the *Laying the seal at the SH26 Roundabout* rock foundation. Kerb and footpath construction will continue where possible as well as landscaping and general clean up works.
