

It's that time of year again! Soccer season is about to start again - 1st match on Sat 8th May.

The Waikato Soccer Association (WaiBOP) will be continuing to have single sex teams from U7 upwards. i.e. girl's teams and boy's teams. This is to improve player development and confidence with the game.

Junior Football: for boys and girls born 2008 - 2014. Games are Saturday mornings on a home and away basis, hopefully at least half at Newstead, half at other fields in Hamilton or greater Waikato. If we do not have enough team members to form a single sex team then we will have to field mixed teams into the boy's



- * Boys and girls are in separate leagues.
