Dear Parents and Whanau,

Thank you to everyone for making our first term of 2021 such an awesome term. We've had a really great term of learning here at school. Children have been happy and engaged in their learning. One of the great things about our school context is that most students start here in New Entrants and leave at the end of Year 6. During this time, we're able to see the children grow and evolve as learners and human beings.

One thing we strive to do here at Newstead is to capture opportunities for deep and authentic learning experiences. This photo was taken a few weeks ago at the end of a very, very wet day. Both Mrs Malcolm and her Graduate Teacher Trainee, Mr Reed, had taken a unit on 'Floatation Devices' which involved planning, design and construction. They were able to capitalise on the wet day (and our poor drainage) to test out the children's floatation devices. I was out watching them. The level of focus and engagement was extremely high. Brain research indicates that when children are having these types of learning experiences, their neural pathways are developing at a faster rate than normal. I will aim to give more examples throughout the year of these types of experiences.

## Waikato District Council – Long Term Plan, make sure you get involved and have your say before 5pm Friday 7 May 2021 <u>CLICK HERE</u>

Our plan, which is reviewed and updated every three years, is asking three key questions this time around. We want to know what general rate increase option you prefer, if we should sell our pensioner housing and if we should continue our inorganic kerbside rubbish collection service. At the same time, we'll also asking for feedback on user fees and charges, our development contributions policy and the community hall catchment review.

If our preferred option is supported, ratepayers will face a 'go hard and go early' 9% average general rate increase in year 1 (2021/22) and then 3.5% for year 2 and 3 of the plan. The other option, a more cautious approach, sets the general rate increase at 7% in year 1, 6% in year 2 and 4% in year 3.


