Telephone Road Closure

The final SH1B rail crossing community survey **closes in one week, at 5pm on Friday 3 November.**

Waka Kotahi has delivered a hard copy (attached) to households in Puketaha considered most affected by the closure of the crossing, but it is also available to complete online at www.nzta.govt.nz/projects/sh1b-telephone-road-rail-crossing/. Please scroll down the page to find it under the heading "Community survey".

This survey seeks community feedback on the feasibility of a new option to keep the rail crossing open - to realign Telephone Rd and to close Holland Rd at the western side of the intersection. This option is costed at \$3-\$4 million and, compared with the cost of the first options proposed to meet safety requirements (\$8-\$11 million), it would more closely rival the cost of permanent closure (\$2.5 million). "The lower cost is significant, since securing funding for an upgrade to allow the intersection to remain open will be challenging."
