

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Newstead School will be having a Wheels Day on **Tuesday**, **13th May (Week 3)**. Students are welcome to bring their 'wheels' to school for a fun and active time slot during the school day. Wheels could include **skateboards**, **scooters**, **bikes and rollerblades**. We are unable to accommodate e-bikes or e-scooters so please do not bring these to school.

Students will be riding in our **new flat car park** area, which provides a safe and smooth space to enjoy their wheels. They will be split into **two groups: 'Juniors and Seniors'**, taking turns throughout the day. Teachers and student teachers will be monitoring all activities and barriers will be in place to help keep everyone safe.
